Gizmo Warm-up

In 1924, a fossilized skull that looked very similar to a chimp skull was discovered. But the skull most definitely did not belong to a chimp. The location of the **foramen magnum**—a hole in the skull where the spinal cord exits—indicated that the individual was **bipedal**, or walked on two legs. This fossil was some of the earliest evidence of human evolution. Using the *Human Evolution – Skull Analysis* Gizmo, you will discover some of the ways that skulls can be used to learn about human evolution. Start by comparing two modern **hominids**: a human and a chimpanzee.
