Heinrich,Joh Karl Scholz,2009-06-02 Work first That is the core idea behind the 1996 welfare reform legislation It sounds appealing but according to Making the Work Based Safety Net Work Better it collides with an exceptionally difficult reality The degree to which work provides a way out of poverty depends greatly on the ability of low skilled people to maintain stable employment and make progress toward an income that provides an adequate standard of living This forward looking volume examines eight areas of the safety net where families are falling through and describes how current policies and institutions could evolve to enhance the self sufficiency of low income families David Neumark analyzes a range of labor market policies and finds overwhelming evidence that the minimum wage is ineffective in
