

## Genetics Test Study Guide

Hello class,

In addition to reading the genetics unit (pages 185-223), the following are some points to remember

- Remember that there are two types of nucleic acids, DNA and RNA
- DNA is double stranded and RNA is single stranded
- The monomers of nucleic acids are nucleotides. Each nucleotide consists of a phosphate, sugar, and base
- The nucleotide, Thymine, is unique to DNA, and Uracil is unique to RNA
- The amount of Adenine will always equal the amount of Thymine in DNA
- The amount of Cysteine will always equal the amount of of Guanine in DNA
- The flow of information goes from DNA to mRNA to protein
- Mutations are mistakes in the DNA...it is when there is a change to the DNA of an organism
- Mutations can occur randomly due to a mistake in the replication of DNA or mutations can occur as a result of radiation or certain chemicals in the environment
- Mutations are usually bad for the organism, but sometimes they lead to the production of new proteins and new characteristics that can be beneficial to the organism. This is the basis for evolution which will be discussed further in our next unit
- Be sure to know how to use the genetic code when provided in order to translate an mRNA into protein
- DNA stays in the nucleus, but RNA is able to leave the nucleus to bring instructions to the ribosomes for protein synthesis
- All of your cells have the same DNA, however, only the genes needed for a particular cell are active. All other genes are turned off...meaning that they are not being transcribed or translated into protein. This is known as differential gene expression
- Things in the environment can affect gene expression, like sunlight
- The first 22 pairs of chromosomes are collectively called the autosomes. The final pair (number 23) is known as the sex chromosomes
- The combination of 2 X chromosomes (XX) produces a female. The combination of an X and a Y chromosome produces a male
- Genetic disorders are diseases inherited due to defective genes being passed down. Usually causes an enzyme to malfunction.
- A carrier for a genetic disease is someone who does not have the symptoms of the disease, but has the ability to pass down a defective gene to their children. The child would need to inherit two copies of the defective gene ( a copy from both parents) in order for the disease to occur.
- Hemophilia is a genetic disease in which individuals lack the ability to properly clot their blood leading to profuse bleeding.
